MINUTES OF A MEETING HELD AT HAVENSTREET COMMUNITY CENTRE, MAIN ROAD, HAVENSTREET ON THURSDAY 24 NOVEMBER 7.00PM

129/11: APOLOGIES FOR ABSCENCE

Apologies were received from Cllr Blezzard and Cllr Gauntlett

130/11 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillor Hattersley declared a personal interest in item 133/11 on the agenda by way of being a resident of Havenstreet and in the remaining items on the agenda by reason of being a member of the IWALC Executive Committee.

131/11 ASHEY MEMORIAL CROSS

The Council noted that the Isle of Wight Council will be carrying out a full restoration of the Cross. When complete, there will be a rededication service. It was requested that enquiries be made as to whether the cross could serve as a memorial to those lost in the Second World War.

132/11 RECREATION GROUND

The Council noted that there is a requirement for a lease to be put in place between Isle of Wight Council and the Parish Council in order for the Parish to secure grant funding for play equipment.

132/11 JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS

The Council noted that the provisional plans for a Jubilee event at Smallbrook Stadium. The Council resolved that Cllrs Hattersley and Bell would attend the next meeting in relation to the event.

133/11 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

P/01488/11 – TCPL/25265/M & P/01489/11 – LBC/25265/L

Leopards Farm, Main Road, Havenstreet

The Parish Council resolved to make **no objection** to this application – seeking assurance that:

Access to neighbouring properties via the shared driveway would not be obstructed by parked vehicles during construction or by residents' vehicles.

That the conversion is in keeping with the age and nature of the property.

P/01577/11 – TCP/03879/M

Waste Transfer Facility, Briddlesford Road

The Parish Council resolved to make **no objection** to this application – requesting that the following concerns were noted:

Vehicles travelling to and from the site would not pass through Havenstreet or Asheby.

The visibility line approaching the entrance to the site from the North is very short; given the nature of Briddlesford Road and current speed restrictions, it was considered that this may be hazardous.

P/01566/11 – TCP/08624/D

Cherrytrees, Main Road, Havenstreet

The Parish Council resolved to defer to the Isle of Wight Council in respect of this application.

P/01529/11 – TCP/30792

Isle of Wight Steam Railway, Havenstreet

The Parish Council resolved to make **no objection** to this application.
